NOTICE TO PLAYERS

THE RULES OF THE UNITED STATES GOLF ASSOCIATION GOVERN PLAY: Complete text of Rules and Local Rules may be found in the Official Guide to the Rules of Golf, effective January 2019. This information also supplements the 2020 PGA Local Rules (Hard Card) and the PGA Covid-19 Procedures.

FORMAT: 18-Holes Individual Stroke Play. The top four (4) scores and ties will advance to the Amateur Championship. All play is from the **BLACK Chambersburg Tee Markers**.

AUTOMOTIVE TRANSPORTATION: Single rider carts are required for the stipulated round and included in your entry fee.

CADDIES: Not permitted.

SCORECARDS: Physical scorecards will not be issued and groups will be given a GGID for scoring on the Golf Genius app on the starting tee. Players should verify their scores at the scoring area at the completion of their round.

SUPPLEMENTAL RULES OF PLAY

OUT OF BOUNDS: Defined by inside edge of white stakes, white lines, split rail fences, public roadways and perimeter fencing. ** The inside edge of the fence posts behind #13 green identify the out of bounds.*

ABNORMAL COURSE CONDITIONS: See Rule 16.1c

- A. Enclosed white-lined areas are defined as ground under repair, see Rule 16. French drains are deemed to be ground under repair.
- B. All mulched areas are **No Play Zones** - MANDATORY relief (flower beds, tee benches, water coolers, and turf nursery left of #16)

BUNKERS: For a ball that lie in a bunker, the player may lift, clean and place – 1 club length no closer to the hole or play the ball as it lie. If lifted, the ball must remain in the bunker. Players may NOT improve the sand in the area of intended placement. Players should smooth their damage in a bunker as much as possible after play from a bunker. Bunker rakes may be removed from the course.

IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS:

- A. Included, but not limited to, all buildings, artificially surfaced roads and paths whether paved or surfaced with gravel or wood chips.
- B. Curbing, walls, steps, drains and permanent structures immediately adjacent to, or abutting, artificially surfaced paths are a part of the same obstruction.

PENALTY AREAS: When marked with stakes and lines, stakes identify and lines define the penalty area. Artificial walls and pilings located in penalty areas are integral parts of golf course.

PACE OF PLAY: 2-Point checkpoint policy in effect. Time allowed to complete stipulated round at Chambersburg Country Club is **3 Hours and 45 Minutes**. Checkpoints will be on holes 9 and 18.
