NOTICE TO PLAYERS

THE RULES OF THE UNITED STATES GOLF ASSOCIATION GOVERN PLAY: Complete text of Rules and Local Rules may be found in the Official Guide to the Rules of Golf, effective January 2019. This information also supplements the 2020 PAGA Local Rules (Hard Card) and PAGA Covid-19 Procedures.

Model Local Rules in effect:

Model Local Rule E-12 (No penalty for a Ball Played from Outside Relief Area when taking back-on-the-line relief)
Model Local Rule G-9 (Permitting Replacing a club significantly damaged other than by abuse)

FORMAT: 18-Holes Individual Stroke Play. The top six (6) scores and ties will advance to the Amateur Championship. All play is from the **YELLOW HANNASTOWN TEE MARKERS**.

AUTOMOTIVE TRANSPORTATION: Carts are required for the stipulated round and included in your entry fee.

CADDIES: Caddies are not permitted for the qualifying round.

BUNKERS: For a ball that lie in a bunker, the player may lift, clean and place – 1 club length no closer to the hole or play the ball as it lie. If lifted, the ball must remain in the bunker. Players may **NOT** improve the sand in the area of intended placement. Players should smooth their damage in a bunker as much as possible after play from a bunker. Bunker rakes may be removed from the course.

PENALTY AREAS: When marked with stakes and lines, stakes identify and lines define the penalty area. Artificial walls and pilings located in penalty areas are integral parts of golf course.

*****Dropping zones are provided for a ball in the YELLOW penalty area of hole #5 and the RED penalty area on hole #7 as an additional option to Rule 17.**

ENVIRONMENTALLY SENSITIVE AREAS: Areas designated as "Wetlands" are environmentally sensitive areas and you may NOT retrieve or play the ball from these areas. A ball lying in any of these areas is to be played as a ball lost in a penalty area. These areas are designated by a green cap on the applicable penalty area stake.

OBSTRUCTIONS: Paved, stone and dirt cart paths are immovable obstructions and relief may be taken in accordance with Rule 16.1a. Wood chipped and areas of bare earth leading into cart paths will have the same status as the path, that of obstructions.

*****Dropping Zone for is provided on hole #9 for a ball that lie between the white lines behind the piling wall of green. The entire white lined area is considered an obstruction.**

OUT OF BOUNDS: Defined by the nearest inside points at ground level of white stakes, white lines, chain-link and all boundary fences. See Rule 18.

GROUND UNDER REPAIR: Enclosed white-lined areas are defined as ground under repair, see Rule 16. French drains are deemed to be ground under repair. Flowerbeds and mulched areas are NOT ground under repair.

PRACTICE AREAS: The practice putting green is a part of the competition course on which players may practice at holes designated for practice only. See Rule 5.2. Practice holes are considered a 'Hole Made by a Greenkeeper'. **The practice range at Hannastown is a significant distance from the starting tee. Players using the practice facility should plan accordingly to be on the starting tee at their assigned time.**

SCORECARDS: Physical scorecards will not be issued and groups will be given a GGID for scoring on the GolfGenius app on the starting tee. Players should verify their scores at the scoring area at the completion of their round.

PACE OF PLAY: The maximum allowable time to complete 18-holes is **3 Hours and 45 Minutes**.
