## NOTICE TO PLAYERS

**THE RULES OF THE UNITED STATES GOLF ASSOCIATION GOVERN PLAY:** Complete text of Rules and Local Rules may be found in the Official Guide to the Rules of Golf, effective January 2019. This information also supplements the 2020 PAGA Local Rules (Hard Card) and the PAGA Covid-19 Procedures.

**FORMAT:** 18-Holes Individual Stroke Play. The top 10 scores and ties will advance to the Middle-Amateur Championship. All play is from the **White PAGA Tee Marks**.

**AUTOMOTIVE TRANSPORTATION:** Carts are required and the fee was included with your entry fee. Caddies are permitted and may ride in the cart.

**SCORECARDS:** Physical scorecards will not be issued and groups will be given a GGID for scoring on the Golf Genius app on the starting tee. Players should verify their scores at the scoring area at the completion of their round.

## SUPPLEMENTAL RULES OF PLAY

**ABNORMAL COURSE CONDITIONS:** Enclosed white-lined areas are defined as ground under repair, see Rule 16. French drains are deemed to be ground under repair.

**\*All flowerbeds containing mulch and flowers are considered ground under repair, relief is mandatory.**

**BUNKERS:** For a ball that lies in a bunker, the player may lift, clean and place – 1 club length no closer to the hole or play the ball as it lies. If lifted, the ball must remain in the bunker. Players may NOT improve the sand in the area of intended placement. Players should smooth their damage in a bunker as much as possible after play from a bunker. Bunker rakes may be removed from the course.

**OBSTRUCTIONS:** Paved cart paths are immovable obstructions and relief may be taken in accordance with Rule 16.1a. Wood chipped and GUR areas leading into cart paths will have the same status as the path, that of obstructions.

- A. Players may take relief from intervention by immovable obstructions on or within two club-lengths of the putting green when the ball lies within two club-lengths of the immovable obstruction.
- B. The arborvitae bushes and fencing to the right of number #18 are to be treated as a temporary immovable obstruction. Intervention along the line of play, as well as interference with stance, swing or lie of the golf ball will be granted relief to the nearest drop zone.
- C. On Hole #9 players may proceed to the nearest drop zone, depending upon their location, for a ball which has interference from the cart path, patio or flowerbed.
- D. Hole #14 pole and support to left of fairway are free relief for stance, lie of ball and area of intended swing. A ball which strikes the pole, supports, or cables must be replayed without penalty.

**OUT OF BOUNDS:** Defined by perimeter boundary fences. See Rule 18.

**PREFERRED LIES:** When a player's ball lies in a part of the general area cut to fairway height or less, the player may take free relief once by placing the original ball or another ball within one club length of the original spot, no closer the hole. The ball must remain in the general area.

**PENALTY AREAS:** Artificial walls and pilings located in penalty areas are integral parts of the course.

**PACE OF PLAY:** 2-Point checkpoint policy in effect. Time allowed to complete stipulated round at Fox Hill Country Club is **4 Hours and 10 Minutes**. Checkpoints will be on holes 9 and 18.
