### **NOTICE TO PLAYERS**

**THE RULES OF THE UNITED STATES GOLF ASSOCIATION GOVERN PLAY:** Complete text of Rules and Local Rules may be found in the Official Guide to the Rules of Golf, effective January 2019. This information also supplements the 2020 PAGA Local Rules (Hard Card) and the PAGA Covid-19 Procedures.

**FORMAT:** 36-Holes Individual Stroke Play. Two 18-hole stipulated rounds. In the event of inclement weather, the championship will not extend past the last scheduled date of Sept. 17. Play will be from the PAGA TEE Markers

**AUTOMOTIVE TRANSPORTATION:** Carts are permitted for the championship. If taking a cart, please check in the golf shop to pay prior to your round.

**SCORECARDS:** Physical scorecards will not be issued and groups will be given a GGID for scoring on the Golf Genius app on the starting tee. Players should verify their scores at the scoring area at the completion of their round.

#### SUPPLEMENTAL RULES OF PLAY

**OUT OF BOUNDS:** In addition to the nearest by the inside points at ground level of white stakes, out of bounds is also defined by the boundary fence/fence posts.

- A. The driving range, short game area, centennial nine and practice putting green are parts of the course players may practice on.
- B. The Centennial Nine is not out of bounds.

**ABNORMAL COURSE CONDITIONS:** Enclosed white-lined areas are defined as ground under repair, see Rule 16. French drains are deemed to be ground under repair.

BUNKERS: For any ball that comes to rest in a bunker, the ball must be played as it lies.

#### IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS:

- A. Include, but are not limited to, all buildings, stone walls, artificially surfaced roads and paths whether paved or surfaced with gravel or wood chips.
- B. Curbing, walls, steps, drains and permanent structures immediately adjacent to, or abutting, artificially surfaced paths are a part of the same obstruction.

PENALTY AREAS: Artificial walls and pilings located in hazards are integral parts of golf course.

\*Dropping zone is provided for a ball in the penalty area (red or yellow stakes and lines) on hole #5 as an additional option to Rule 17. \*\*Dropping zone is provided for a ball in the penalty area (yellow stakes and lines) on holes #11 and #13 as an additional option to Rule 17.

**PACE OF PLAY:** 2-Point checkpoint policy in effect. Time allowed to complete stipulated round at Huntingdon Valley Country Club is **4 Hours and 25 Minutes.** Checkpoints will be on holes 9 and 18.

**SECOND ROUND STARTING TIMES:** Times will be from the first tee only from the highest to the lowest score. Times will be email to players and posted online.

**PLAYOFF:** There will be a sudden death playoff for any ties for the Championship.
