NOTICE TO PLAYERS

THE RULES OF THE UNITED STATES GOLF ASSOCIATION GOVERN PLAY: Complete text of Rules and Local Rules may be found in the Official Guide to the Rules of Golf, effective January 2019. This information also supplements the 2020 PAGA Local Rules (Hard Card) and the PAGA Covid-19 Procedures.

FORMAT: 18-Holes Individual Stroke Play. The top 18 scores and ties will advance to the Middle-Amateur Championship. All play is from the **White PAGA Tee Marks**.

AUTOMOTIVE TRANSPORTATION: Carts are required and the fee was included with your entry fee. Caddies are permitted and may ride in the cart.

SCORECARDS: Physical scorecards will not be issued and groups will be given a GGID for scoring on the Golf Genius app on the starting tee. Players should verify their scores at the scoring area at the completion of their round.

SUPPLEMENTAL RULES OF PLAY

OUT OF BOUNDS: Defined by the nearest inside edge at ground level of white stakes, white lines and chain link boundary fences. The driving range left of #1 is out of bounds. The swimming pool area (defined by fencing) and parking lot is out of bounds.

ABNORMAL COURSE CONDITIONS: Enclosed white-lined areas are defined as ground under repair, see Rule 16. French drains are deemed to be ground under repair.

***Mulched, prepared areas, such as flower beds are to be considered ground under repair, relief at the player's option.**

BUNKERS: For a ball that lies in a bunker, the player may lift, clean and place – 1 club length no closer to the hole or play the ball as it lies. If lifted, the ball must remain in the bunker. Players may NOT improve the sand in the area of intended placement. Players should smooth their damage in a bunker as much as possible after play from a bunker. Bunker rakes may be removed from the course.

IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS:

- A. Paved and stone cart paths are immovable obstructions. Worn turf and ground under repair areas leading into cart paths will have the same status as the path.
- B. Players may take relief from intervention by immovable obstructions on or within two club-lengths of the putting green when the ball lies within two club-lengths of the immovable obstruction.

PRACTICE GROUND: The practice putting and chipping greens are parts of the competition course that players may practice. They are wrong putting greens, relief is mandatory.

****The practice putting green (back portion) of the 18th green is in play during play of the 18th hole.**

PENALTY AREAS: Red lines and stakes define the margins of penalty. When both lines and stakes define such margins, the lines govern. Artificial walls and pilings located in penalty areas are integral parts of the course.

PACE OF PLAY: 2-Point checkpoint policy in effect. Time allowed to complete stipulated round at Schuylkill Country Club is **3 Hours and 45 Minutes**. Checkpoints will be on holes 9 and 18.
