



# 104<sup>TH</sup> Open Championship Qualifying Country Club of Harrisburg July 23, 2020



## NOTICE TO PLAYERS

**THE RULES OF THE UNITED STATES GOLF ASSOCIATION GOVERN PLAY:** Complete text of Rules and Local Rules may be found in the Official Guide to the Rules of Golf, effective January 2019. This information also supplements the 2020 PAGA Local Rules (Hard Card) and the PAGA Covid-19 Procedures.

**FORMAT:** 18-Holes Individual Stroke Play. The top six (6) scores and ties will advance to the 104<sup>th</sup> Open Championship. All play is from the **Blue club tee markers**.

**AUTOMOTIVE TRANSPORTATION:** Single rider carts are required for the stipulated round and included with entry fee. Caddies are Not permitted.

**SCORECARDS:** Physical scorecards will not be issued and groups will be given a GGID for scoring on the Golf Genius app on the starting tee. Players should verify their scores at the scoring area at the completion of their round.

## **SUPPLEMENTAL RULES OF PLAY**

**OUT OF BOUNDS:** Defined by the nearest inside edge at ground level of white stakes, white lines, boundary fences and public road ways. On Holes #3-4-5-6-9-11-12-15-18. The parking lot, Pool Area, Tennis Courts and Clubhouse area are out of bounds and defined by fences, stakes, or white lines. See Rule 18.

**ABNORMAL COURSE CONDITIONS:** Enclosed white-lined areas are defined as ground under repair, see Rule 16. French drains are deemed to be ground under repair.

**\*The practice bunker is in the "General Area" and consider ground under repair, relief is mandatory.**

**PRACTICE GROUND:** The practice green is a "Wrong Putting Green".

**BUNKERS:** For a ball that lies in a bunker, the player may lift, clean and place – 1 club length no closer to the hole or play the ball as it lies. If lifted, the ball must remain in the bunker. Players may NOT improve the sand in the area of intended placement. Players should smooth their damage in a bunker as much as possible after play from a bunker. Bunker rakes may be removed from the course. Players may use bunker rakes, but are not required too.

**FLAGSTICKS:** Players are NOT permitted to touch flagsticks.

**IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS:** Paved, stone and dirt cart paths are immovable obstructions and relief may be taken in accordance with Rule 24-2b. Wood chipped and GUR areas leading into cart paths will have the same status as the path, that of obstructions. The Cement drain culvert's on hole #1 are considered "Immovable Obstructions".

**PENALTY AREAS:** When marked with stakes and lines, stakes identify and lines define the penalty area. Artificial walls and pilings located in penalty areas are integral parts of golf course.

**\*Hole #15 – As an additional option for a ball hit into the penalty area short of the green, players may proceed to the drop zone.**

**PACE OF PLAY:** 2-Point checkpoint policy in effect. Time allowed to complete stipulated round at Country Club of Harrisburg is **3 Hours and 45 Minutes**. Checkpoints will be on holes 9 and 18.
