NOTICE TO PLAYERS

THE RULES OF THE UNITED STATES GOLF ASSOCIATION GOVERN PLAY: Complete text of Rules and Local Rules may be found in the Official Guide to the Rules of Golf, effective January 2019. This information also supplements the 2020 PAGA Local Rules (Hard Card) and the PAGA Covid-19 Procedures.

FORMAT: 54-holes of Stroke Play. Three 18-hole stipulated rounds. Cut to low 40 and ties for third round. All play is from the **YELLOW PAGA Tee Marks.**

CADDIES: Players may hire a caddie, bring a caddie, or carry their own bag. Carts are NOT permitted.

SCORECARDS: Physical scorecards will not be issued and groups will be given a GGID for scoring on the Golf Genius app on the starting tee. One player in the group is required to keep score. Players should verify their scores after each hole and at the scoring area at the completion of their round.

PLAYER LUNCHES: Lunch will be provided for all competitors at the nine stand (halfway) and was included with your entry fee. Additional lunch purchases will be available for caddies on a cash basis.

SUPPLEMENTAL RULES OF PLAY

OUT OF BOUNDS: Out of Bounds is defined by inside points at ground level of white stakes, white lines, and fence posts. The bridges behind the first and tenth green are out of bounds.

ABNORMAL COURSE CONDITIONS: Enclosed white-lined areas are defined as ground under repair, see Rule 16. French drains are deemed to be ground under repair.

*All flowerbeds are ground under repair and NO PLAY ZONES, relief is mandatory.

BUNKERS: For any ball that comes to rest in a bunker, the ball must be played as it lies.

FLAGSTICKS: Players are permitted to remove flagsticks.

IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS: Paved or crush rock cart paths are immovable obstructions and relief may be taken. All shelters should be treated as immovable obstructions.

PRACTICE GROUND: The practice putting green and driving range are a part of the competition course on which players may practice.

PENALTY AREAS: When marked with stakes and lines, stakes identify and lines define the penalty area. Artificial walls and pilings located in penalty areas are integral parts of golf course.

PLAY-OFF: In the event of a tie for the 104th Open Championship, a sudden-death playoff will begin immediately following the conclusion of play.

PACE OF PLAY: 4-Point checkpoint policy in effect. Time allowed to complete stipulated round at Oakmont Country Club is **4 Hours and 33 Minutes.** Checkpoints will be on holes 4, 9, 13 and 18.







