**NOTICE TO PLAYERS**



**THE RULES OF THE UNITED STATES GOLF ASSOCIATION GOVERN PLAY:** Complete text of Rules and Local Rules may be found in the Official Guide to the Rules of Golf, effective January 2019. This information also supplements the 2020 PAGA Local Rules (Hard Card) and the PAGA Covid-19 Procedures.

**FORMAT:** 36-Holes Individual Stroke Play. **Senior Tee:** RED PAGA Tee Markers | **Super-Senior Tee:** Blue PAGA Tee Markers

**AUTOMOTIVE TRANSPORTATION:** Single rider carts are permitted. Caddies are permitted. Pull carts are permitted.

**SCORECARDS:** Physical scorecards will not be issued and groups will be given a GGID for scoring on the Golf Genius app on the starting tee. Players should verify their scores at the scoring area at the completion of their round.

### SUPPLEMENTAL RULES OF PLAY

**OUT OF BOUNDS:** Defined by inside points at ground level of white stakes, white line and boundary fences.

- **The course side edge of Mine Hole Road on #10 and of Reading Furnace Road on holes #11 and #18.**
- **The course side edge of Cottage Lane left of hole and behind green on hole #11**
- **The course side edge of the white line on Bulltown Road on hole #16**
- **The OLD course is not out of bounds.**
- **A ball which crosses a public road defined as out of bounds and comes to rest beyond that road is out of bounds, even though it may lie on another part of the course.**

**ABNORMAL COURSE CONDITIONS:** Enclosed white-lined areas are defined as ground under repair, see Rule 16. French drains are deemed to be ground under repair.

**BUNKERS:** For a ball that lies in a bunker, the player may lift, clean and place – 1 club length no closer to the hole or play the ball as it lies. If lifted, the ball must remain in the bunker. Players may NOT improve the sand in the area of intended placement. Players should smooth their damage in a bunker as much as possible after play from a bunker. Bunker rakes may be removed from the course.

#### IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS:

1. include, but are not limited to, all buildings, stone walls, artificially surfaced roads and paths whether paved or surfaced with gravel or wood chips.
2. Curbing, walls, steps, drains and permanent structures immediately adjacent to, or abutting, artificially surfaced paths are a part of the same obstruction.
3. The Cottages, parking areas and all adjacent decorative planting areas are a single immovable obstruction.
4. In taking relief from stonewalls on hole #1 and #2 the player must determine the nearest point of relief without crossing over, through or under the obstruction.

**PRACTICE GROUND:** The practice putting green, short game area and driving range are a part of the competition course on which players may practice.

**PENALTY AREAS:** When marked with stakes and lines, stakes identify and lines define the penalty area. Artificial walls and pilings located in penalty areas are integral parts of golf course. **#16 - The lateral penalty area left of the fairway extends to and coincides with the out of bounds margin (defined by the course side white line on Bulltown Road)**

**WEATHER:** Should weather delay play beyond the end of the day on Tuesday, Aug. 4, the competition will not be extended, and the championship will be shortened to 18 holes.

**PLAY-OFF:** In the event of a tie in either division of 61<sup>st</sup> Senior Amateur championship, a sudden-death playoff will begin immediately following the conclusion of play.

**PACE OF PLAY:** 2-Point checkpoint policy in effect. Time allowed to complete stipulated round at Lookaway Golf Club is **4 Hours and 15 Minutes**. Checkpoints will be on holes 9 and 18.
