NOTICE TO PLAYERS

THE RULES OF THE UNITED STATES GOLF ASSOCIATION GOVERN PLAY: Complete text of Rules and Local Rules may be found in the Official Guide to the Rules of Golf, effective January 2019. This information also supplements the 2020 PAGA Local Rules (Hard Card) and the PAGA Covid-19 Procedures.

FORMAT: 18-holes stroke play qualifying. Top 16 players advance to match play. There will be a playoff immediately following the conclusion of play for the final match play positions. All play will be from the RED PAGA Tee Markers

AUTOMOTIVE TRANSPORTATION: Is Permitted; Players have the option to walk. Maximum of two carts per group. If taking a cart, please check in the Proshop to settle your cart fee. Caddies are NOT permitted.

SCORECARDS: Physical scorecards will not be issued and groups will be given a GGID for scoring on the Golf Genius app on the starting tee. Players should verify their scores at the scoring area at the completion of their round.

PLAY-OFF: In the event of a tie for the final match play positions, a sudden-death playoff will begin immediately following the conclusion of play. Playoff rotation: 10, 17, 18 (repeating if needed). All matches that are tied after 18 holes will return to hole 1.

SUPPLEMENTAL RULES OF PLAY

OUT OF BOUNDS: Defined by the nearest inside edge at ground level of white stakes, fences, green stakes with white tops and fence posts, public roads, and club driveway. See Rule 18.

- Inside edge at ground level of the parking lot and circular drive around the putting green, and roped fence left of hole #14 define Out of Bounds.
- A ball on or over road to the right of holes #5 and #9 is out of bounds.
- Hole # 18 Out of Bounds is defined by Link fence surrounding swimming pool. A ball on or over paved path immediately behind the #18 green is Out of Bounds. Defined by nearest course side edge of the paved path.

ABNORMAL COURSE CONDITIONS: Enclosed white-lined areas are defined as ground under repair, see Rule 16. French drains are deemed to be ground under repair.

BUNKERS: For a ball that lies in a bunker, the player may lift, clean and place – 1 club length no closer to the hole or play the ball as it lies. If lifted, the ball must remain in the bunker. Players may NOT improve the sand in the area of intended placement. Players should smooth their damage in a bunker as much as possible after play from a bunker. Bunker rakes may be removed from the course.

IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS:

- The House to the Left of Hole # 5 is considered an "Immovable Obstruction".
- The Maintenance Area to the left of # 7 is considered an "immovable Obstruction".
- The Greenside Ventilation Fans should be treated as "Temporary Immovable Obstructions".

PENALTY AREAS: Artificial walls and pilings located in penalty areas are integral parts of golf course.

Yellow lines define and stakes identify the margins of yellow penalty areas. Red lines define and stakes identify the margins of red penalty areas.

• As an additional option for a ball that comes to rest in the RED penalty area on #6, players may proceed to the drop zone.

PACE OF PLAY: 2-Point checkpoint policy in effect. Time allowed to complete stipulated round at Country Club of York is **4 Hours** and **25 Minutes.** Checkpoints will be on holes 9 and 18.
